

Sustainable Public Procurement-fiche: advanced

1) Subject matter

Electric hot-air dryers produced with environmentally friendly materials and who are more environmentally friendly in use.

“For <.....> (name of the public authority), the care for the environment and social aspects is important. It is stated in her <strategic policies>, <mission>, <vision>, <procurement policy>, ...”

2) Exclusion criteria

Non compliance with environmental and social legislation, which has been the subject of a final judgment or a decision having equivalent effect, may be considered an offence concerning the professional conduct of the economic operator concerned or grave misconduct, permitting to exclude the party concerned from competing for the contract

Energy consumption

Starting out from a relative drying period of 30 seconds the maximum energy consumption is 0.017 kWh.

Plastic parts

The plastics used for the hot-air hand driers are marked in accordance with DIN 54840 or ISO 11469.

Chemical requirements

- Polybrominated diphenyls or polybrominated diphenyl ethers are not used for the flame protection of the plastic parts.
- No cadmium-plated parts are used.
